The ICW is a three-day conference organised by a partnership of weighing industry associations from all over the world and international organisations OIML and BIPM. It is a key event for everyone involved in measurement by bringing together researchers, industry and authorities worldwide. The 1st ICW in 2023 was successfully held in Germany with 230 participants from 25 countries.

The focus of the ICW2026 is 'Innovative Weighing Solutions for a Sustainable World'. During the three days, there will be a number of oral presentations on state-of-the-art developments regarding scientific, legal and applied metrology and lectures by prominent figures including a Nobel laureate. It will be an excellent opportunity to meet relevant stakeholders from various backgrounds in the measurement sector from all over the world!

Poster Contents and Specifications

We welcome a variety of research themes, not limited to the field of weighing, from universities, research institutes and private companies. We look for research topics that you would like to introduce to the field of metrology, such as AI (image recognition/classification), new sensor technology, gravitational acceleration, automation, digitalization and sustainability, or that can be utilized in the field.

- Both ongoing research projects and already-published ones are accepted.
- The poster size may be up to 841 mm x 1189 mm. The poster should be displayed in portrait orientation.
- The language used on the poster and during the presentation should be English.
- Posters should be prepared as a single poster or multiple posters pieced together. No audiovisual equipment is permitted.
- Push pins for attaching posters to the board will be provided on-site.

Placing and Removing Your Poster

All poster boards will be numbered, and presenters will be informed of their number in advance. All presenters are asked to bring their posters to the venue and set them up on June 7, 2:00pm-5:00pm or June 8, 8:00am-10:00am and remove them in the afternoon on June 10.

The organizer will dispose of posters left behind at the end of the conference.

Participation fee for Poster Presenters

Free of charge (one person per poster)

Presenters will be provided with lunch on June 8-10 and invited to the welcome reception at the night on June 8. Presenters will be able to attend plenary sessions and parallel sessions during the ICW. All co-authors who would like to join presenters during the session and help answer questions must be registered for the meeting.

Application Procedure

Interested presenters are requested to submit their poster abstract through an online system by March 31, 2026:

1. Sign up as ConfAid user.

The ConfAid will automatically send an e-mail for confirmation after you have created a user account. If you can not find the confirmation e-mail, it may have been sent to your spam box.

2. Log into ConfAid to proceed with your submission.

Submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the ICW Steering Committee on demand, and authors will be notified whether their abstracts are accepted or rejected by email in a timely manner. Please obtain permission from your supervisor or advisor before submission.

Poster Abstract

Poster abstract should include the following items:

(a) Title (b) Author/Affiliation (c) Abstract (Up to 400 words in English)

The format can be downloaded from the online registration system.

Poster Abstract Submission period

July 1^{st,} 2025 -March 31, 2026, 23:59:59 JST.

Publication of Proceedings

Printed proceedings will be distributed to ICW participants. Poster presenters are requested to submit a manuscript by April 17, 2026. Author guide for proceedings will be notified to presenters after acceptance notification. A short summary of the poster will be accepted, especially for unpublished topics, for the proceedings.

ICW Poster Session Award

Outstanding posters will be selected for awards. A review of the selection will be done during the session. Awarded posters may be considered for publication in the OIML Bulletin*.
